What is meant by the word "glory"? From a human standpoint it connotes high renown or honor that has been won by notable achievements. It's frequently applied to great athletes. We hear it used as well to describe certain countries and governments down through history. The glory of The Roman Empire, for instance, has been celebrated and written about extensively.

But what does "glory" mean from a biblical perspective? In both the Old and New Testaments, we find references to the visible display of God's presence, shining forth like a million suns. One theologian has described glory "as a way of revealing the essential nature and character of God."

A little over a week ago we began a new sermon series in The Gospel of John. Interestingly, the entire book of John is built around this word "Glory". In chapter 1, verse

14 we read, "The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the One and Only, Who came from the Father, full of grace and truth." (John 1:14, NIV) Then throughout the rest of John's 21 chapters we are "seeing His glory displayed before our eyes and ears, not in spectacular bursts of light as described by Moses in the Torah, or in the books of Isaiah or Revelation, or St. John's account of Jesus' transfiguration to three of His closest disciples, but in the miracles, life, and teachings of the God-man, Jesus Christ.


As a result of these, says St. Paul, we are being changed. You and I are being transformed from the inside out! (2 Corinthians 3:18) We are in the process of, not becoming gods, but certainly - becoming like God.

Fascinatingly, there is reference in the Bible to those who believe, reflecting God's glory in quite a literal way, shining in other words. In that universal favorite, "Amazing Grace", John Newton alludes to this as he writes, "When we've been there ten thousand years, Bright shining as the sun, We've no less days to sing God's praise, Than when we first begun." Yes, I believe we who are in Christ, will look very different than we do now – we will glow, much as Moses' face glowed when he came down from meeting with God on Mt. Sinai. We will go from mortality to immortality, from darkness to light, from a state of reprobation to perfection and reconciliation.

Let me invite and encourage you then to join us in worship as we Journey Through John; that as we explore God's glory in Christ, we may indeed be changed, ongoingly perfected in every way as The Apostle Paul writes about in his Letter to The Corinthians and be, each one of us, personally inspired to continually bring glory, praise, honor, and adoration to our beloved God and Savior, Jesus Christ.

I want to share some numbers with you for our new conference. A year ago, the second wave of churches were just beginning to migrate from our former denomination into the Global Methodist Church.

There were less than 100 churches in th? Allegheny West Conference. Today, there are over 580 churches and over 420 pastors. First Annual Conference, ordained 143 clergy, organized 23 circuits, 100 appointments, and organized eight new church starts.
