ALLEGHENY WEST ANNUAL CONFERENCE 2024

Before I share about our upcoming Annual Conference, let me pass along a word about VBS 2024. The Children's Council would like to announce that Bellpoint will host Outback Rock VBS on Friday, June 28 through Sunday, June 30th. Outback Rock is a weekend VBS developed by Group Publishing. We will have a Friday evening session and a Saturday morning session. Sunday there will be a brief recap and celebration during the 10:30 AM service. Outback Rock will help kids "venture into solid faith." If you'd like to help lead this VBS or serve as a group leader, please call Pastor Paul or leave a message with the church office. As in the past, we will also give our members the opportunity to help with the donation of materials and supplies. In mid-May, flyers will be available for this event and we're encouraging our folks to pass them along to those families they believe would be interested in joining us on this great adventure. We wanted to give everyone plenty of notice about VBS 2024 so they could get it on their

calendars, but keep your eyes open for forthcoming information and ways to help.

Now, some may think, "Didn't we just had an Annual Conference in October?" The answer is of course – Yes, we did. This was our Allegheny West Convening Conference, however. May 22nd through the 25th we will have our first regular Annual Conference at Mount Vernon Nazarene University. Please, be in prayer for this event. Our focus will be on "Building Together." What are we planning on building, you ask?

As The Global Methodist Church wants to be far more than just United Methodism 2.0, we'll be taking steps to live into a fresh vision for the church that intentionally seeks to revitalize individuals whole congregations on a worldwide scale, helping men and women effectively spread The Good News of Jesus Christ.

The Conference is seeking to challenge and encourage its members and leaders to become "History Makers" in the way our founder, John Wesley and the early Methodists were, literally changing the world in their day and significantly impacting the lives of literally millions of souls.

To achieve this goal one the GMC will be partnering with The International Leadership Institute, an organization developed by a former UMC missionary and graduate of my alma mater, Asbury Theological Seminary. The cabinet for our annual conference has already gone through this incredible training. Next, every pastor within our conference will be required to go through the same training and then take it back to their congregations, leading as many members as are willing through the ILI program.

The focus of this training is around eight core values. I can't go into great detail but will list them for you. They are Intimacy, Passion, Vision, Evangelism, Multiplication, Family, Stewardship, and Integrity. When opportunity arrives to participate in ILI, I sincerely hope that you will plan on being a part of it. Testimonies highlight how life-changing ILI has been and cited the significant impact ILI has had on building up local churches and ministries and missions around the world. You can check out ILI by going to <u>iliteam.org</u>.

Lastly, let me encourage you to give to *The Miracle Offering* to be taken up during our Annual Conference. The President of AWGMC, Dr. Jeff Greenway explains: "The Miracle Offering goal for 2024 is \$150,000. Funds will go toward meeting some immediate needs related to our Annual Conference Mission Partnership with the Kenya-Ethiopia Conference. Rev. Wilton Odongo, the President Por-Tempore of the Kenya-Ethiopia Conference, and his leadership have a pressing need for the following:

- * 6 motorcycles—these will be used by the Presiding Elders to itinerate in their circuits. The cost of each motorcycle is \$1,500 for a total of \$9,000.
- * 1 used SUV vehicle to be used by the President Pro Tempore to give him dependable transportation as he itinerates across Kenya. Persons familiar with Kenya indicate that this is an absolute necessity. The cost for a used SUV is estimated to be \$35,000.
- * Provide the mandatory classes in Global Methodist History, Polity, and Doctrine that 50 pastors in Kenya need to take before they can be ordained next year. The total estimated cost of providing the class for 50 clergy (which includes transportation, tuition, books, lodging, food, and registering the school with the country of Kenya) is \$50,000.

Our Kenya-Ethiopia Mission Partnership Team would also like to develop an escrow of at least \$50,000 to help bridge the gap of needs until we can build the partnership between the circuits in Allegheny West and Kenya-Ethiopia."

As you can see, our leadership is determined to put its money where its mouth is. We identify as a global or worldwide denomination and so we are committed to helping our sister churches in different parts of the world to become History Makers too. Checks can be made out to Bellpoint Community Church. Please, indicate in the memo portion that your gift is designated for the 2024 Miracle Offering of the GMC West Allegheny Conference. So grateful for your thoughtful support of this endeavor.


