From the feedback I've received from both parents and youth and my own observations, I'd have to wholeheartedly agree, and I don't think I'm being the least bit biased even though Dom is one of my sons-inlaw.

all this time. Zane has been so helpful in developing a strong youth program here at Bellpoint. (Zane also will be stepping down as a volunteer in youth ministry.) This fruitful season for Dom and Zane is coming to a close. Yet, I'm confident that God has new and equally exciting opportunities for service in His name awaiting both of these wonderful young men.

Now, having made this announcement, I'm pleased to follow it with this encouraging news. Our own Emily Carpenter, a recent grad of Cedarville, will be stepping in as our youth ministry interim. Her time of service will last at least until the start of the new year, as she will eventually be transitioning to the mission field in order to serve refugees from the Middle East. (There will be opportunity for our congregation to support Emily in this calling. More to come later.)
