# THAT'S WHAT COUNTS

The Acton Institute blog pointed to a recent short video of Denzel Washington offering some spontaneous career advice to a group of young actors. Although the setting is informal and his remarks are off-the-cuff and unrefined, his views align with some key themes of Christian stewardship. Given that we typically focus on stewardship during the month of November, I thought I'd share what Washington had to say:

"I pray that you all put your shoes way under the bed at night so that you got to get on your knees in the morning when you wake up to find them. While you're down there, thank God for grace and mercy and understanding. We all fall short of the glory ... but if you just start thinking about all the things you got to say "thank you" for, that's a day. That's easily a day! You'll never see a U-Haul behind a hearse ... Now, I've been blessed to make hundreds of millions of dollars in my life. I can't take it with me, and neither can you. It's not how much you have but what you do with what you have. And we all have different gifts: some money, some love,

some patience, some the ability to touch people. But we all have it. Use it. Share it. That's what counts."

counts." The Scriptures certainly teach that it matters how we use the resources with which God has blessed us. That's what counts! God gives us these things in order to provide for ourselves and our families, of course, but it goes far beyond this. We believe He desires for us to model His own generosity, that through giving a percentage of our income to support the mission and ministry of Bellpoint Community Church, we can help others in our congregation, in our local community, and beyond - grow in their relationship with God, and in His name demonstrate mercy and kindness to those in need. So, we believe stewardship is far more than just meeting a budget and paying the bills. It's a much higher purpose than that.

In truth, it has the equally high purpose of forming the character of God, Himself, in us, Who, out of His great love, gave His all for our benefit.

Our sincerest thanks in advance for your participation in this year's stewardship emphasis,






### **Barn Dance**


